Subject Reappointment of a Board Member Report

Report Number 7.1

RECOMMENDATION

 That the Victor Harbor Horse Tram Authority Board receive and note the Reappointment of a Board Member Report.

2. That the Victor Harbor Horse Tram Authority Board recommend to Council, Natasha Hunt be reappointed as Independent Board Member for a third term commencing on 1 March 2025 and concluding 1 March 2028.

INFORMATION

Purpose

The purpose of this report is for the Authority to consider and recommend to Council to give consideration to reappointing Natasha Hunt as an Independent Board Member for a third term.

Background

The Victor Harbor Horse Tram Authority Charter sets out the requirements for a Board Member to be eligible for reappointment as follows:

- 2.9.5 A Board Member is eligible for reappointment at the expiration of a term of office except that no person shall hold office as a Board Member for more than three consecutive terms.
- 2.9.6 Prior to the conclusion of the term of office of any Board Member, a further appointment will be made by the Council.
- 2.9.7 The Council must give to the Authority a written notice of appointment of a Board Member.
- 2.9.8 Each Board Member must give to the Authority a signed written consent to act as a Board Member.

At the Ordinary Council meeting held on Monday, 28 March 2022, Council reappointed Natasha Hunt to the Victor Harbor Horse Tram Authority as an Independent Board Member for a three-year term commencing on 1 March 2022.

Commentary

With Natasha Hunt's term concluding on 1 March 2025, Natasha has indicated she wishes to be reappointed to the Board for a third term.

As the Board has entered an established and effective stage, it's considered to be advantageous for the Authority to recommend to Council to consider it and reappoint Natasha Hunt to the Authority Board for a third term. The advantages of reappointing existing board members will ensure the Authority retains their knowledge and valuable skills.

The terms of remaining Independent Board Members, Nigel Catt and Paul Brown's term is due to conclude on 1 March 2027. Rachel Kennedy's term is due to conclude on 1 March 2026, so with Natasha's term concluding on the 1 March 2028, if reappointed, this will make sure that no more than two Board Members terms of office expire in the same 12 month period.

RISK ASSESSMENT

The risks associated with the recommendations have been assessed as follows:

Legal and Compliance – The recommendations meet the requirements of the Victor Harbor Horse Tram Authority. This risk is assessed as *low*.
